★ BASIC TOURNAMENT INFO

Texas Hold 'Em Tournament

- Estimated number of players: 70 to 100.
- \$50 buy-in:
 - > \$2,000 worth of chips
 - > One ticket for a chance to win "Super Door Prizes"
 - > Two drink tickets
- Final table of eight people will win one of eight "MEGA Door Prizes" worth at least \$100.
- SPONSOR A FULL TABLE at the preliminary round for \$500.
(This includes \$2,000 chips for 7 players, two Super Door Prize Tickets for each player, and UNLIMITED drinks for the table during the first round.)

★ EXCITING PRIZES

Because gambling is illegal in Nebraska, participants will win chances at door prizes rather than cash.

- Regular Door Prizes: pay \$5 for 20 tickets or win 20 tickets at Bingo
 - Prize values between \$1 and \$25
- Super Door Prizes: available only to those who play Texas Hold'Em or Bingo
 - Prize values between \$25 and \$100
- MEGA Door Prizes: available only to the eight lucky people who make it to the final table
 - Prize values **start** at \$100, and includes a \$500 cash prize

★ FOOD, MUSIC AND MORE!

- **Bingo:** For those that don't like to play Texas Hold 'Em or get bumped out, try your hand at Bingo for chances to win Door Prizes and Super Door Prizes.
- **Lunch:** Served from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. including pulled pork sandwiches or hamburgers with cole slaw and baked beans.
- **Celebrity Dealers:** Celebrities will be on hand to deal a few hands. Enjoy the opportunity to meet people in the spotlight around Omaha and elsewhere.
- **Money Match:** Modern Woodmen Fraternal Organization has agreed to match the money raised – **up to \$2,500!**
- **Live Band:** Fast Track will play starting around 7 p.m. \$10 cover with free admission for Legion members. Cake to be served at the concert/dance.

THE FINE PRINT

TEXAS HOLD'EM DETAILS:

Buy-in cost is \$50 (pre-event ticket sales are available for seat reservation). Your \$50 will buy \$2,000 worth of chips, two drink tickets, and one Super Door Prize ticket. Participants will be seated at tables of seven. There will be a limit of 48 hands dealt for these preliminary rounds. If someone loses all of their chips within the first hour, they will be given the chance to buy back in if there are enough people for a table. At the completion of the preliminary round, those who still have chips will be "flighted" so that each table is fairly even in chip count. Additional chips may be purchased at this time (\$2,000 increments for \$50). Play will resume for another 48 hands. At the conclusion of the flighted round, the top six chip holders are automatically advanced to the final table of eight. The number seven and eight chip holders are "on the bubble." Anyone in the audience who wants a seat at the final table can at this time purchase enough chips to beat the number of chips held by the two "bubble" players (of course, the players on the "bubble" have the opportunity to buy-up to stay at the table). For example, if a player finishes the second round with \$5,000 in chips while the number eight "bubble" player holds \$9,100 in chips, that player must buy an additional \$6,000 in chips (or \$150) to beat the "bubble" player for the last seat at the final table. Likewise, if an audience member has NO chips, he/she can buy a seat at the final table for \$10,000 chips (or \$250) unless a bubble player buys additional chips. Chips can only be purchased in \$2,000 increments (for \$50). Once the final two seats are determined, the final eight will play 48 hands. Each player seated at the final table is guaranteed one of the Mega Door Prizes. Players who did not secure a seat at the final table but who still have chips can cash them in for tickets for door prizes and super door prizes (\$200 chips = an arm length of door prize tickets or one Super Door Prize ticket). At the end of the final table, chips are cashed in for MEGA Door Prize tickets (\$1000 chips = one MEGA Door Prize ticket). The only difference is that the player can put their tickets toward the door prize they wish to win to improve their chances of winning that prize.

BINGO DETAILS:

Don't play Texas Hold'Em but want to come to have fun? Then Bingo is the game for you. The winner(s) of each game will receive their choice of an arm length of door prize tickets or a Super Door Prize ticket. Different types of Bingo games will be played as well as "Frequent Flyer Bingo" – games only available to those who have played multiple rounds (fewer people qualify, so your chances to win are greater - plus the prize is larger). Bingo will be played in the back room at the Legion.
